



## No Tank $\checkmark$ devices have been added.

The first time you use your Tank √ sensor, press the "Sync" button 5 times in a row to initialize it. To add new sensors make sure the scanning icon is spinning and then hold down the sync button on your Tank √ until it is found.

When app is first opened, it will begin a search for sensors.

Once a sensor Sync button is pressed, the sensor will then appear in the sensor list.





Adding more sensors will keep adding to the sensor list.

There is no limit on the number of sensors that can be added. *(However, some devices may become slower when a high number of sensors are connected. Mopeka has tested 50 sensors connected to one device with no problems.)* 





Selecting a sensor from the list takes you to the screen for that sensor only.





Battery indicator shows condition of the battery in the sensor.

Signal indicator shows strength of wireless signal between sensor and smart device.

Quality scale gives an indication of the quality of the sonic pulses traveling thru the tank, to and from the sensor.

When installing sensor on tank, it is important to check this scale. A low quality is typically indicative of an installation problem, such as poor placement on the tank, debris or excessive paint, etc.

When quality is low, you might also see readings that jump around from time to time. Placing the sensor properly such that quality scale is high, ensures consistent and accurate readings.
